The speaker says: "And it has, you know, built-in light and entertainment features, including LCD displays that <u>play some quite dramatic music</u>, which kind of reaches a crescendo just as the doors are opening at the top." Lift users can therefore hear exiting sounds on their way up.

The speaker says: "Dr. Lee Gray [...] says the <u>fundamental technology hasn't changed much</u> since the '60s." The basic concept the lift works with is therefore not really new.

2

The first speaker says: "[...] the elevator's computerized brain has to figure out the optimal way to get everyone where they need to go."

The second speaker says: "So <u>the math to sort out the traffic control</u> and how quickly the elevators move and stop has become quite extraordinary." Burj Khalifa's elevator traffic has therefore been optimized by using calculations.

The speaker says: "But because Dubai is a bit far, I visited the new headquarters of Legg Mason in Baltimore, <u>which has a similar system</u>." Compared to the one in Dubai the U.S. firm's lift is therefore much the same.

The speaker says: "<u>It already knows where you're going</u>, and <u>the lift will only stop at your floor</u>. Often there aren't any buttons to push." When users enter the lift they are therefore taken to their destination.

The first speaker says: "And Schindler [...] says they're working on a cell phone app that will schedule a lift even before you've arrived in the building. Gone will be wait times, but also <u>gone will be chance</u> encounters with people from other floors."

The second speaker says: "Many people in corporate settings use elevator rides for the so-called elevator pitch or elevator talk to pitch an idea, to talk to a colleague. *Destination Dispatch* <u>could separate people</u> <u>who in the past might travel [sic.] together</u>." New elevator software will therefore minimize socializing.

The speaker says: "Keith Marshall is one of the last truly manual elevator operators in the world [...]. In a few weeks, however, <u>his job will become extinct as the lift becomes automatic</u>." Elevator automation will therefore force the Washington D.C. lift attendant to look for a new job.
